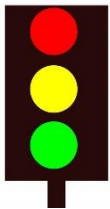
Ali and her team provided a cooked English breakfast today ahead of a celebration day at Chase Park. Thank you to Ali for helping with the breakfasts this week.

As Year 6 have completed their revision programme and SATs, we are now able to start Year 4 Reading Plus sessions every morning at 8.30.
